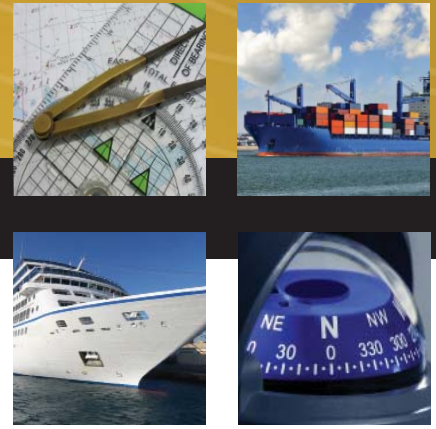

Officers undergo training that focuses on advance planning, preparation for all contingencies, and effective communication to ensure a high level of awareness throughout the entire facility or vessel. All training, certification and processes are based on regulations and standards specific to the maritime industry, including MTSA, ISPS, the International Transfer in Arms Regulation (ITAR), the Electronic Code of Federal Regulations Title 33 for Navigation and Navigable Waters (33 CFR 105), and emerging anti-piracy guidelines.
